The Cedar Rapids Metro Economic Alliance and Greater Iowa City, Inc. annually recommend and support positions on key policy issues affecting our region and state's economic growth. These positions and recommendations are made with significant input from our combined 2,000 members, investors, partners, and community stakeholders.

## **GOAL:** Invest in Talent Development & Regain Educational Leader Status

A strong education system that aligns with the needs of the business community is critical to meeting our region's workforce needs. Iowa must support innovative education initiatives and programs that develop workplace skills. Additionally, we must continue expanding employer involvement in developing workforce programs that align with PK-12, community colleges, universities, and private institutions to build a talent pipeline and attract the best and brightest to Iowa.

To regain our status as the best education system in the nation we need to promote high-quality teachers, create personalized learning by tracking student progress, invest in continuing education training programs and in early childhood education options and reward improved outcomes.

Access to quality education systems from early childhood and K-12 to postsecondary education and on-the-job training is vital to lowa's economic growth. As we continue to become a more diverse state, we must develop policies that promote employment expansion, income growth and wealth development for all residents.
