

# **BLP Application**

The Board Leadership Program (BLP) was created by Greater Iowa City, Inc., the Community Foundation of Johnson County, and the United Way of Johnson & Washington Counties. It is a 6-month education series for individuals with professional or volunteer experience, preparing them to serve as confident and effective board members for local nonprofit organizations. Participants receive training and learn about opportunities in the greater Iowa City area.

#### Selection Criteria

Preference is given to individuals who:

- can attend all sessions and program events
- intend to serve the Johnson County area

All applicants will be notified by September 1, 2025 of the committee's decision.

#### **Tuition**

Tuition is \$250 and includes all program fees and materials.

If you are accepted, you will be invoiced for tuition and payment will be due by program orientation on September 24, 2025. Unfortunately, we are unable to refund tuition to those who leave the program early or are disqualified from graduation.
